Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	No.	This <u>plan</u> covers items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount.
Are there other <u>deductible</u> for specific services?	No.	You don't have to meet <u>deductible</u> s for specific <u>services</u> .
What is the <u>out-of-pocket</u> <u>limit</u> for this <u>plan</u> ?	For In- <u>Network</u> \$2,000 person / \$4,000 family	The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <u>plan</u> , they have to meet their own <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> until the overall family <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> has been met.
What is not included in the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> ?	Premiums, balance-billed charges, and health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the <u>out-of-</u> pocket limit.

You will pay the most if you use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> , and you might receive a bill from a <u>provider</u> for the difference between the provider's charge and what your <u>plan</u> pays (<u>balance billing</u>). Be aware, your <u>network provider</u> might use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> for some services (such as lab work). Check with your <u>provider</u> before you get services.
Do you need a <u>referral</u> to see a <u>specialist</u> ?	No.	You can see the <u>specialist</u> you choose without a <u>referral.</u>

Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes
